

Category Tracker

As you gather, the same **thing** turns up everywhere — cables in three drawers, scissors in four rooms. Log each category here as it surfaces, until you've tracked down **all** of it (that's the “I own *fourteen* USB cables” moment). Then give it a home.

Whole — you've tracked down every stray **Homed** — given its place (one home, or a few)

Categories are the things, not the places — e.g. USB cables · batteries · pens · scissors · chargers · spare bulbs · tools · medicines · candles.
